COUNT ONE

The SPECIAL APRIL 2025 GRAND JURY charges

On or about September 29, 2025, at Chicago, in the Northern District of Illinois, Eastern Division,

FABIAS SHIPMAN,

defendant herein, knowing that he had previously been convicted of a crime punishable by a term of imprisonment exceeding one year, did knowingly possess, in and affecting foreign commerce, ammunition, namely, one 10mm auto caliber round with a headstamp of “PPU 10mm AUTO,” which ammunition had traveled in foreign commerce prior to defendant’s possession of the ammunition;

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 922(g)(1).

FORFEITURE ALLEGATION

The SPECIAL APRIL 2025 GRAND JURY alleges:

1. Upon conviction of an offense in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 922(g), as set forth in this Indictment, defendant shall forfeit to the United States of America any firearms and ammunition involved in and used in the offense, as provided in Title 18, United States Code, Section 924(d)(1) and Title 28, United States Code, Section 2461(c).

2. The property to be forfeited includes, but is not limited to, one 10mm auto caliber round with a headstamp of “PPU 10mm AUTO,” and associated ammunition.
